In 2013, 66,061 people were directly employed across local health and social care organisations in Northern Ireland; the vast majority (81%) were women. Overall between 2004 and 2013, the Northern Ireland Health and Social Care Workforce increased by 12.3% which means that this is a growth employment sector in Northern Ireland.
